- **WARNING:** Extension cords are not recommended for use with this product.
- **WARNING:** The blades are not affixed to the unit. They are removable and very sharp. Handle with care!
- A CAUTION: In order to avoid a hazard due to inadvertent resetting of the thermal cut-out, this appliance must not be supplied through an external switching device, such as a timer, or connected to a circuit that is regularly switched on and off by the utility.

IMPORTANT: This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

Children shall not use or play with this appliance. Close supervision is necessary to keep appliance and cord out of reach of children during use.

For ingredient storage in the cup, use Sip & Seal® Lid or spout lid to cover.
- A CAUTION: Do not blend dry ingredients unless pulsing for short intervals per the instructions. Continuous blending dry ingredients will overheat the blender.
- 6 To protect against electrical shock, do not submerge the appliance or allow the power cord to come into contact with water or any other liquid.
- 7 **DO NOT** allow the appliance to be used by children. Close attention is necessary when used near children. This is not a toy.
- 8 Never leave an appliance unattended when in use.
- 9 Turn the appliance off and remove the power cord from the electrical outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, accessing

- parts that move while in use and before cleaning. To unplug, grasp the plug and pull from the electrical outlet. Never pull from the power cord.

- 21 **DO NOT** operate this appliance on or near any hot surfaces (such as gas or electric burner or in a heated oven).
- 22 The use of attachments or accessories including canning jars, not recommended by the manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock or personal injury.

- 23 **DO NOT** remove any container from the motor base while the appliance is in operation. Always unplug the unit when not in use.
- 24 To reduce the risk of injury, **NEVER** operate the appliance without the blade assembly in place; **DO NOT** try to defeat the interlock mechanism; make sure that the attachment is properly installed before operating the appliance.
- 25 **DO NOT** expose containers to extreme temperature changes.

- 27 **DO NOT** operate the appliance empty.
- 28 If the appliance overheats, a thermal switch will become activated and shut off the motor. To reset, unplug the appliance and let it cool down for approximately 30 minutes before using again.
- 29 To reduce the risk of burns, always allow the appliance to cool before taking off parts and before cleaning.





- 1 Remove all packaging material and labels from the appliance. Separate/remove all parts from each other.
- 2 Wash the lids, cups, and Pro Extractor Blades™ Assembly in warm, soapy water. When washing the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly, use a dish-washing utensil with a handle to avoid direct hand contact with blades.
- ▲ CAUTION: Handle the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly with care when washing, as the blades are sharp.
- 3 Handle blade assemblies with care to avoid contact with sharp edges. Rinse and air dry thoroughly.
- 4 Cups, lids and Pro Extractor Blades Assembly are all dishwasher safe. It is recommended that the lids and Pro Extractor Blades Assembly be placed on the top rack. Ensure that the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly is removed from the containers or grinder before placing in the dishwasher.
- **5** Wipe the motor base clean with a damp cloth.



- **1** Review warning and caution statements above before proceeding to number 2.
- 2 Place the motor base on a clean, dry, level surface such as a counter or tabletop. Press down on the motor base to make sure that the suction cups adhere to the counter or tabletop.
- **3** Make sure that the motor base is plugged in for use. When the unit is plugged in and no cup installed, "--" is displayed on the timer.
- 4 Add ingredients to the cup.
 - NOTE: Do not overfill! To avoid spilling, do not add ingredients past the "MAX" fill line.
- **5** Place the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly onto the cup and twist it on tightly until you have a good seal.
- **6** Turn the cup upside down and place it onto the motor base, aligning the tabs on the cup with the motor base. Turn it clockwise, until you feel it click into place. The Timer light will illuminate. (Fig. 2)
- 7 Press one of the buttons to activate. (Fig. 3)

- **NOTE:** When using the Auto-iQ[®] presets, the unit will operate using pulses, pauses and continuous runs. The pauses allow the contents of the cup to settle. When the timer reaches "0", it will stop by itself.
- To remove the cup, ensure that the motor has stopped running. Then turn the cup anticlockwise (Fig. 4) and pull straight up to remove. (Fig. 5)
- Turn the cup upright and remove the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly by twisting the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly anticlockwise. (Fig. 6)
- 10 Do not store blended contents in the Nutri Ninja Cup with the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly attached.
- 11 Place the Sip & Seal Lid or spout lid onto the Nutri Ninja Cup, twist to seal and enjoy.
- 12 For storage, only use Sip and Seal Lid or spout lid to

Care & Maintenance

HOW TO CLEAN

- ▲ CAUTION: Make sure that the motor base is unplugged from the power source before inserting or removing any attachment and before cleaning.
- A CAUTION: DO NOT immerse the motor base into water or any other liquid.
- Separate/remove all parts from each other.
- **2 Hand Washing**: Wash containers, lids, and Pro Extractor Blades Assembly in warm, soapy water. When washing the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly, use a dish-washing utensil with a handle to avoid direct hand contact with blades. Handle the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly with care to avoid contact with sharp edges. Rinse and air dry thoroughly.

Dishwasher: Containers, lids, and Pro Extractor Blades Assembly are all dishwasher safe. The lids and Pro Extractor Blades Assembly are top rack dishwasher safe. Ensure that the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly are removed from the containers before placing in the dishwasher.

- ▲ WARNING: Handle the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly with care when washing, as the blades are sharp. Contact with the blades' edges can result in laceration.
- **3** Wipe the motor base clean with a damp cloth.

HOW TO STORE

1 Store the Nutri Ninja® with Auto-iQ® upright with the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly inside the corresponding container with the lid secured on top. Do not place anything on top. Store the rest of the attachments in a safe place where they will not be damaged and won't cause harm. Secure the power cord underneath the base by wrapping the cord around the cord wrap.

NOTE: Do not store blended or unblended ingredients in the Nutri Ninja Cup with the blade assembly attached.

RESETTING THE MOTOR THERMOSTAT

The Nutri Ninja with Auto-iQ features a unique safety system which prevents damage to the unit's motor and drive system should you inadvertently overload your appliance. If the appliance is being overloaded, the motor will stop. To reset the appliance, follow the resetting procedure below:

- Unplug the appliance from the electrical outlet.
- **2** Remove and empty the cup and ensure that no food is jamming the Pro Extractor Blades Assembly.
- Allow the appliance to cool for approximately 30 minutes.
- Re-install the cup onto the base and re-plug the appliance into the electrical outlet.
- **5** Proceed to use the appliance as before while making sure not to exceed the recommended maximum capacities.

^{*} When blending sauces, make sure they're cooled to room temperature first - Ninja® containers are not intended for hot blending.

Troubleshooting Guide

PROBLEMS	POSSIBLE REASONS & SOLUTIONS		
Unit doesn't turn on	Make sure the unit is plugged in. When the unit is plugged in and no jar installed, "" is displayed on the timer. Insert and rotate cup clockwise in the base until it "clicks". The timer light will illuminate.		
Unit doesn't turn off	Remove cup from base by rotating cup anticlockwise and lifting out. Display should turn off. Unplug the power cord from the outlet.		
Lid/blade assembly hard to assemble	Set the cup on a level surface. Place the lid or blade assembly on the top of the cup and align the threads so that the lid/blades sit flat on the cup. Twist clockwise so that the lid/blades evenly align to the cup until you have a tight seal.		
Food is not evenly chopped	For best results when chopping, make sure all ingredients are as dry as possible. Cut pieces down to even sizes, and reduce the amount of food in the cup. Use very short pulses by quickly pressing the "PULSE" button.		
Doesn't mix well, food gets stuck.	 Using the Auto-iQ™ programs is the easiest way to achieve great results. The pulses and pauses allow the food to settle towards the blade. If food is routinely getting stuck adding some liquid will usually help. When packing the cups, start with fresh items, then powders/nuts. Add liquids, and finally frozen items or ice. 		
Motor base won't stick to counter or tabletop	Make sure surface and suction feet are wiped clean. Suction feet will only stick to smooth surfaces. Suction feet WILL NOT stick on some surfaces such as, wood, tile and non-polished finishes. DO NOT attempt to use appliance when the motor base is stuck to a surface that is not secure, (cutting board, platter, plates, etc.).		
Unit is difficult to remove from counter for storage	Tip unit forward from the back to easily disengage the suction feet.
